RULES AND REGULATIONS

Market Management

Trumpet of Yahveh is responsible for the operation, management, and administration of its events. Trumpet of Yahveh has the authorization to make operational and administrative decisions including but not limited to the application, interpretation, and enforcement of these rules. Trumpet of Yahveh hereby establishes Melissa Lane (620-513-8049) as market coordinator.

Vendor Expectations

Vendors are expected to collaborate positively with Trumpet of Yahveh, fellow vendors, and customers. Uncooperative and offensive behavior will not be tolerated. Vendors may be requested to leave for any such behavior and may be banned from any future events. Vendors are expected to respond to any necessary correspondence from the market coordinator. Vendors are individually responsible for complying with any local, state, and federal sales tax regulations. Vendors must abide by all applicable local, state, and federal rules and regulations. Any vendor selling food products must be in full compliance with any applicable licensing and labeling requirements. Children of any vendor shall be the sole responsibility of the vendor, appropriately watched and supervised.

Vendor Application

Each vendor must submit an application to the market coordinator and be approved prior to the vendor exercising the privilege of selling at the vendor's first event. The application shall also include copies of all appropriate certificates, permits, and licenses. No vendor fee is currently charged.

Booth Set-Up and Tear-Down

Market events are held within the main sanctuary room. Each vendor will be allotted a 6' long table and surrounding space for use and display. If a vendor requires additional tables or space, the vendor must arrange for such with the market coordinator ahead of the event. At the conclusion of each event, vendors must remove all displays and sale items. Vendors are required to be at the market site thirty (30) minutes before opening time with set-up completed before opening time. Spaces are allotted on a first come, first served basis.

Sale Items Not Allowed

No items or substances illegal through local, state, or federal law may be sold. In accordance with Trumpet of Yahveh's scriptural understanding, crosses or stars of David or items with crosses or stars of David within them are not permitted. No multilevel marketing items, such as Mary Kay, Avon, or Scentsy, may be sold.

Exchanges and Refunds

Exchanges or refunds of any market items will be left to the discretion of the vendor.
