Tabernacles is a picture of the future reign of the Messiah. Let us practice now this Holy Convocation of Yahveh. We are not sure just what and how to do a Holy Convocation, but Ezra gave us an indication of what to do.

"Day after day, from the first day to the last, Ezra read from the Book of the Law of God. They celebrated the feast for seven days, and on the eighth day, in accordance with the regulation, there was an assembly." Neh 8:18

The book of Nehemiah is precious to us as believers. It is a look at an ancient time when the Law and Ways of Yahveh were lost,. The people were held captive by Satan's ways. Then came redemption, return and repentance and the hearts of the people melted like wax. The Law, Yah's instructions for holiness, was read and the people learned to keep the Holy-Days once again. With fear and trembling they were working out their salvation. I pray that we too will learn the ways of the Father what pleases Him and Him alone. And we too will with fear and trembling work out our salvation by the High Calling the Father has given to HIS own.

Those who have studied the Scriptures and history in which the Messiah lived as a man, believe that the Messiah was born on either the Fall Feast of Trumpets or Tabernacles. He came the first time to "Tabernacle" for 33 years. The second coming will be with the Sound of the Shofar on the great and terrible day of Yahveh to conquer, to judge, to reign, and to "Tabernacle". It is a Feast Day. "Therefore let us keep the Festival, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth."

Paul is actually speaking here about Passover, but don't you think ALL of Yahveh's Feasts are to be kept? Do not substitute pagan holidays for the Holy Days of your Father.

The Fall Feasts:

To be gathered to Him: Trumpets
To be Judge: Atonement

An added question that I just cannot ignore:

"Are you invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb"? If you intend to be a part of the bridal procession, perhaps you truly need to look at the Feast of Tabernacles. It is a feast for the joining of the marriage supper of the Lamb.

"Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory!

For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and His bride has made herself ready. Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear." Rev 19:7-8



Yahveh's Holy Day: The Ingathering of HIS HOLY people.

Live in a "tent" for a Week?
Why?

SUKKOT TABERNACLES



Tabernacle: Yahveh, Creator, wanted mankind to "tabernacle" with Him in the Garden of Eden. Man chose his own way. Tabernacle means (I) A place or house of worship. (2) A dwelling (3) A meeting place (4) Habitation, tabernacle, tent. Who would not want to "tabernacle" with the Father on HIS Holy day!?

THE BEGINNING

It all begins in the wilderness when Yah's people left the pagan government of Egypt. He wanted a people Holy unto Himself. He gave them instructions to build a "special tent", a "dwelling", for Himself. — "a Tabernacle". Instructions were exact: the ark of the covenant was placed in the center Most Holy Place. Yahveh would dwell with His people. Moses would be the "Intercessor" between Yahveh and the people, much like The High Priest as Yahshua (Jesus) is intercessor to His Believers.

Yahveh said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites: 'On the fifteenth day of the seventh month Yahveh's Feast of Tabernacles begins, and it lasts for seven days. The first day is a sacred assembly; do no regular work. For seven days present offerings made to Yahveh by fire,

and on the eighth day hold a sacred assembly and present an offering made to Yahveh by fire. It is the closing assembly; do no regular work. ("'These are YAHVEH'S APPOINTED FEASTS, which you are to proclaim as sacred assemblies for bringing offerings made to Yahveh by fire-the burnt offerings and grain offerings, sacrifices and drink offerings required for each day. These offerings are in addition to those for Yahveh's Sabbaths and in addition to your gifts and whatever you have vowed and all the freewill offerings you give to Yahveh.) "So beginning with the fifteenth day of the seventh month, after you have gathered the crops of the land, celebrate the festival to Yahveh for seven days; the first day is a day of rest, and the eighth day also is a day of rest. On the first day you are to take choice fruit from the trees, and palm fronds, leafy branches and poplars, and rejoice before Yahveh your God for seven days. Celebrate this as a festival to Yahveh for seven days each year. This is to be a LASTING ORDINANCE for the generations to come; celebrate it in the seventh month. Live in booths for seven days: All native-born Israelites are to live in booths so your descendants will know that I had the Israelites live in booths when I brought them out of Egypt. I am Yahveh your God.'" Lev 23:33-43

Ok, your first answer to this would be; "I am not a native-born Israelite". My answer is: "Yahveh ordained this for HIS PEOPLE, are you HIS? Yahshua died for you to become HIS chosen People". And, "A man is not a Jew if he is only one outwardly, nor is circumcision merely outward and physical. No, a man is a Jew if he is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. Such a man's praise is not from men, but from God." Rom 2:28-29 It is of the HEART that you keep the Holy-Days of Yahveh your Elohim!

This Feast day is indeed a week of fun. Think about this; If you made it through "The Trumpet Call" when HE comes again on His white steed and you made it through the "Day of Judgment", you indeed would be celebrating; would you not? Listen to what the Father says about this feast in the millennial reign.

"Then the survivors from all the nations that have attacked Jerusalem will go up year after year to worship the King, Yahveh Almighty, and to celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles. If any of the peoples of the earth do not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, Yahveh Almighty, they will have no rain. If the Egyptian people do not go up and take part, they will have no rain. Yahveh will bring on them the plague he inflicts on the

nations that do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles. This will be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of <u>all</u> the nations that do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles. zech 14:16-19 I want to belong to the Nation of Yahveh who are already keeping the Feast of Tabernacles. Remember it is a heart condition to keep HIS Holy Convocation Days plus He expects His people to know they need to keep it. How? By reading and doing the Word.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 15th day of the seventh month of the Biblical Calendar, not our Gregorian Calendar. The Biblical Calendar starts with Passover being in the 1st month, which usually makes the "15th day" of the seventh to come in our September or October. The "15th day" means the 15th day after the first sighting of the new moon of that month. Yah's calendar is much different than our calendar.
- 2. This feast is to last 7days. Actually 8. With special assemblies on the 1st and 8th days.
- 3. Special offerings are to be brought to the assembly. These are different than regular tithe offerings. These are special offerings set aside for this feast. In the agricultural era of the Israelites; their offerings were those of the land. "Celebrate the Feast of Ingathering at the end of the year, when you gather in your crops from the field. Ex 23:16
- 4. And always a sacrifice by fire was offered. Yahshua was, is and will always be our blood sacrifice....He provided the blood atonement. When you understand the purging of fire you can readily understand why the offering was by fire. We too will be purged by the fire of trials and tribulations. And hopefully we will endure until the end.
- Do no work on the 1st and 8th day. They are HOLY. Biblical license to REST.
- 6. Take fruit, fronds, leafy branches and poplars and REJOICE before Yahveh!
- 7. This is a LASTING ORDINANCE, never to stop.
- 8. Live in Booths (tents) for seven days
- Reminder that the Father brought a people for Himself out of bondage and they dwelt with Him in Tents for 40 years.
- 10. It is an APPOINTED FEAST
- 11. According to Zech 14, you will regret not coming up
